Hal Nissley has BS and MS from Case Western Reserve University and a BS in Law from Peninsula College of Law. He also is a Registered Professional Engineer.

Hal is active in venture capital and angel investing and has been a direct investor in 54 start-ups and on the Board of Directors of 24 of them. From 1982 to 1988, Hal managed a seed fund, and all got 12:1. Currently, he is Chairman of Angel Capital Network, which owns a Broker Dealer (Investment Bank). International Angel Investor's official mission statement emphasizes Hal's interests: "Mentor about corporate governance and finance for better investing." Hal's future plans include joining the Boards of a new medical instrument firm and a new ATM services firm.
