Dr. Gloria Hom is the Chairman of and Professor in the Economics Department at Mission College and Division Chairman for the Social Science. She has served as an adjunct instructor at San Jose State University and the University of California, Santa Cruz. She was named "Outstanding Educator of America" and Trustee Emeritus for the California State University system. She has served as President of the California Teachers Association, West Valley Chapter, the State Academic Senate and the Mission College Academic Senate. She was a member of numerous other boards and committees, including the Advisory Committee of the White House Conference on Library and Information Services, Board of Trustee of the California State University, and the Sallie Mae Board of Directors. She has also authored numerous journal articles.

Dr. Hom was awarded a Bachelor's degree from Dominican College, San Rafael, a Masters Degree from San Jose State University, and completed a Doctorate in Education in the area of Leadership and Organization at the University of San Francisco. She did further graduate work at Stanford University and the University of California.
