Topic: **Energy**

Speaker: **James Sweeney, Professor of Management Science and Engineering, Stanford University**

Professor James L. Sweeney is Professor of Management Science and Engineering, an affiliated faculty member of the Department of Economics, and a Senior Fellow of the Stanford Institute for Economic Policy Research. Until September 1999, he served as chairman of the Stanford Department of Engineering-Economic Systems and Operations Research.

He has focused his professional activities on the application of economics methods and mathematical modeling, particularly to natural resource issues, energy economics, environmental economics, competitive analysis, and policy analysis. He has conducted theoretical research on depletable and renewable resource use, environmental economics, gasoline market dynamics, energy tariff policy, and housing market dynamics. He has conducted empirical research on energy demand, electricity demand and financial forecasting, and geothermal energy market behavior. Along with Alan Kneese, he was editor of the three volume *Handbook of Natural Resource and Energy Economics*, part of the *North Holland Handbooks in Economics* series.

He holds a B.S. degree from MIT in Electrical Engineering and a Ph.D. from Stanford University in Engineering Economic Systems. His articles have appeared in numerous books and journals, including *Econometrica*, *Journal of Economic Theory*, *Resources and Energy*, *Management Science*, *Journal of Urban Economics*, and *The Energy Journal*.
